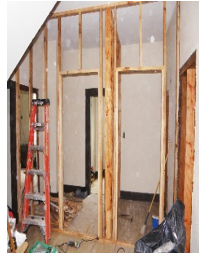

The Madrona Project December 2009



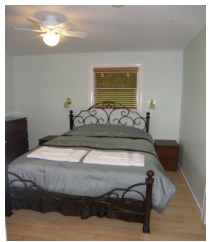

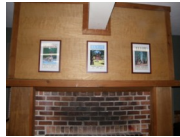
The Meeting House Sound System
